The 69.181.v.2.00 software use in addition to the normal calibration procedure absolute calibration in mV/V. When updating from earlier versions a factory calibration with an absolute reference (simulator) is necessary. Three password protected commands for factory calibration has been added:

FZ 890420 Factory Zero – this command will store the 0.0mV/V result in the LDU.

FG 890420 Factory Gain – this command will store the 2.0mV/V result in the LDU.

FS 890420 Factory Save – this command will save the factory calibration to the EEPROM.

Step by step procedure:

- 1. Download the new program to the LDU.
- 2. Use the FD command to store the updated settings in the EEPROM Remember the CE command first.
- 3. Connect a simulator to the LDU.
- 4. Set the input to 0mV/V and issue the FZ command see below.
- 5. Set the input to 2mV/V and issue the FG command see below.
- 6. Issue the FS command to store the results in the EEPROM.
- 7. Reset the LDU.

NOTE: When doing the actual calibration (point 4 and 5) wait 10 to 20 seconds after changing the simulator before giving the command.
